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Ribbon cutting ceremony to celebrate the opening of Members First Credit Union's student-run branch inside Booker T. Washington High School

Washington High School with a ribbon cutting ceremony on <u>Wednesday, September 26, 2018</u>. Select community and school leaders will hear remarks from B. T. Washington High School officials and Members First Credit Union beginning promptly at 10:00 a.m. The ribbon cutting and photo opportunity will take place at 10:20 a.m. followed by light refreshments and a tour of the Credit Union Branch.

Students will earn course credit and gain hands-on experience as they run daily operations of the Branch, including opening new checking and savings accounts, making deposits and withdrawals, and transferring money.

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The Branch will provide convenient access to students, staff, and their families during the school day and by appointment. Members First employees will provide financial education seminars to students, faculty, and staff, as well as help support Washington High School's financial literacy curriculum. Students who were selected to run the branch received in-depth training during the summer which prepared them for operating the Credit Union Branch at Washington High. They'll receive experience and build skills in finance, leadership, management, and marketing which will tie back to the core classes taught in the Marketing and Entrepreneurship Academy at Washington High School.

"All of our staff and our students here at Booker T. Washington High School are happy to welcome our newest business partner, Members First Credit Union. Having their branch operating in the heart of our school makes them part of the *Wildcat* family," said Dr. Michael Roberts, Booker T. Washington's Principal.
